In 2001 Job's Daughters International was granted a 501 (c) 3 not-for-profit status by the IRS and the Voting Delegates approved the merger of the Supreme Guardian Council, IOJD with Job's Daughters International. At that historic Session, the Daughters and adults selected a new emblem to represent our new name.

To launch the new emblem, our official jeweler Doc Morgan Inc. was commissioned to produce a 10K gold filled Limited Edition Jewel of the JD International trademark. 150 Limited Edition jewels were produced and numbered. Jewel # 1 will be on permanent display in the Ethel T. Wead Mick Memorial Room at the International Center. More than half of the jewels are already being worn by our members and dedicated adults.
