**GENERAL INFORMATION**

***TRANSPORTATION***

By Air: It is most convenient to fly into the Dane County Airport in Madison (30 minutes from Marriott), or General Mitchell Field in Milwaukee (aprx. 1.5 hr. drive).

***IDENTIFICATION AND SECURITY***

Session identification badges must be worn at all times. Day passes are required for those not registered for the entire session (\$15 in advance, \$25 at session).

***CHAPERONES AND CONDUCT***

All Daughters under the age of 20 must be chaperoned while moving about the facility and at any time when leaving the facility, including tours. A chaperone must accompany Daughters to the pool areas.

***DRESS CODE***

**Formal Banquet, Opening, Installations, Pageant:** Long or street length dressy dresses, coats and ties for men.

**Meetings (including Supreme Bethel):** Dresses for ladies, slacks and shirt for men.

**Tours:** Nice casual wear, as appropriate for destination.

**Rehearsals:** Nice casual wear, no jeans or shorts – please; dresses for Supreme Bethel.

**Honored Queens and Princesses** (Bethel, GB, SB, Jurisdictional) should all bring their own official attire (whether it be their official dress, cape, crown, or JDI regalia).

***REHEARSALS***

Rehearsals are on STRICT time limits. Please be prompt!

***INFORMATION ON SITE***

When arriving at the Marriott to register, please check the marquee inside the lobby areas for the location and hours of registration, the time and location of various events, check-in for competitions, updates on tours and announcements.

***TICKETS FOR EVENTS WITH A CHARGE***

If attending a meal function, dance, etc. that requires a ticket, be sure to order it in advance and to secure a one-day pass if you are not registered for Session. Badges will be checked at these events, and tickets will be collected.
