

Arts and Crafts Competition Supreme Session 2008

Competition Rules

1. Daughters submitting an entry or entries must be in good standing with the JDI as of July 22, 2008.
2. The article/item must have been entirely made by the Daughter submitting the entry between the time period of August 2007 and July 2008, the Supreme Guardian Council year.
3. Entries will be judged in two (2) groups by age and experience, as follows: 10-15 years, and 16-19 years.
4. All entries must describe the item in detail. The entry must be what is described —substitutions will not be accepted.
5. All registrations must be POSTMARKED BY JUNE 30, 2008 For a nominal fee a Certificate of Mailing may be obtained from the Post Office (in the USA, it is form 3617). The certificate will verify the date the registration was mailed. In the event that the registration gets lost in the mail, a copy of the Certificate of Mailing, and a copy of the registration will be accepted as proof the registration was mailed by the June 30, 2008 deadline. No registration forms will be accepted at the Session. If you wish acknowledgement of your registration, enclose a SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE or EMAIL ADDRESS with your registration form.
6. Judging will be held on Wednesday, July 30, 2008. When judging has been completed, the room will be open so entries can be viewed. NO VIEWING WILL BE ALLOWED DURING JUDGING. When judging is complete, the room will be open for viewing until 5:00 p.m.
7. A Daughter may enter only one article/item per category. A Daughter does not have to be in attendance to enter. If entries are being brought in by someone other than the Daughter, all items for a Daughter should be in a group together when checking in the items to the Committee.
8. Each Daughter must decide in which Division and Category she wishes her entry to be judged. However, in fairness to all Daughters, the Arts and Crafts Committee reserves the right to adjust categories.
9. All entries must be presented to the Arts and Crafts Committee by Tuesday, July 29, 2008 before 4:00 p.m. in the room listed in the session program and newspaper. No entries will be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on July 29, 2008.
10. The decision of the Judges is final. A minimum number of points must be earned for placing in all categories.
11. Each Daughter must include a typed or printed 3" x 5" card attached to the entry containing the following information.

NOTE: Points are deducted if: 1) a card is not attached; 2) card is not typed or printed clearly; or 3) card is missing any information.

12. All entries must be check in AND out. The SGC, Arts and Crafts Committee and Judges will NOT be responsible for lost or damaged entries. Every precaution possible will be taken to guard against theft or damage.
13. Each Daughter entering the competition will be responsible for packing material. Packing material left in the competition will be discarded.
14. The Committee plans to have all entries available for viewing on Thursday, July 31, 2008 from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
15. Scrapbook entry forms MUST include the name of the person who will pick up the scrapbook — not just a Bethel number.
16. Entries must be checked out (claimed) by the Daughter on Friday, August 1, 2008 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Any entry not picked up will be turned into LOST and FOUND.

Division Category Numbers

Division 1: Photography

Division 4: Computer Generated Art

- Category 1: Original creation (use of drawing programs)
- Category 2: Graphic (use of commercial graphics/art in project acceptable)

Division 5: Other Art

- Category 1: Collage
- Category 2: Miscellaneous

ALL ENTRIES IN DIVISION 1 THROUGH 5 MUST BE MATTED AND HAVE STURDY BACKING. THE ENTRIES MAY BE FRAMED, BUT THIS IS NOT REQUIRED.

Division 6: Handicrafts

- Category 1: Ceramics, pottery — handmade
- Category 2: Ceramics — from mold
- Category 3: Paper mache, decoupage
- Category 4: Woodworking
- Category 5: Leather crafts
- Category 6: Jewelry
- Category 7: Metal work
- Category 8: Dolls, stuffed toys, soft sculptures, toys, games

Division 7: Needlework

- Category 1: Counted Cross Stitch, Embroidery, Crewel — using purchased kit or chart
- Category 2: Counted Cross Stitch, Embroidery, Crewel — original design
- Category 3: Knitting or Crocheting — using purchased kit or chart
- Category 4: Knitting or Crocheting — original design
- Category 5: Needlepoint — using purchased kit or chart
- Category 6: Needlepoint — original design
- Category 7: Latched, macramé wall hanging — using purchased kit or chart
- Category 8: Latched, macramé wall hanging — original design
- Category 9: Plastic canvas

Division 8: Quilts

- Category 1: Pieced quilt larger than wall hanging
- Category 2: Appliquéd quilt larger than wall hanging
- Category 3: Pieced wall hanging
- Category 4: Appliquéd wall hanging
- Category 5: Any other pieced item
- Category 6: Any other appliqued item

Division 9: Job's Daughters Installation or Related Items

- Category 1: Carrying pieces
- Category 2: Centerpieces
- Category 3: Silk Flower Designs
- Category 4: Miscellaneous Items

Division 10: Scrapbooks

- Category 1: Individual (relating to “ONE” person)
- Category 2: Bethel (relating to “the BETHEL” many persons)

Division 11: Miscellaneous

- Category 1: Miscellaneous — does not fit into any category above.
