SUPREME BETHEL REGISTRATION

All Job's Daughters attending the 2008 Supreme Session are encouraged to register for the selection (drawing) of the Supreme Bethel Officers and Representatives for 2008-2009.

AGE

All Daughters who are in good standing and have not turned 20 years old prior to Friday, August 1, 2008 are eligible for all floor offices, and representative positions. If a Daughter is interested in a position as a line officer, she must be an Honored Queen or a Past Honored Queen, at least 16 years old and have a Letter of Intent which must be signed by her parents(s) or legal guardian.

LOCATION

The Supreme Bethel Registration Table will be located in the lobby of the Marriott Convention Center.

REGISTRATION HOURS

Someone will be at the Registration Table during the following hours:

- Monday: 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM
- Tuesday: 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM
- Wednesday: 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

SUPREME BETHEL REGISTRATION WHAT DO YOU NEED TO BRING TO REGISTER

DUES CARD: You must have a **CURRENT** dues card. A Daughter cannot be “vouched for.” There will be no exceptions.

CHAPERONE: You must come **WITH** your chaperone and complete a registration card. Your chaperone will be required to sign the registration card.

SUPREME SESSION REGISTRATION BADGE: This is provided in the registration packet that was picked up by the adult who submitted the information for Supreme Session. This badge will be punched by the Supreme Bethel Committee once you have registered for the drawing.

LETTER OF INTENT: If you wish to be in the drawing for a position as a line officer, you must be an Honored Queen or a Past Honored Queen, at least 16 years old; you **MUST** have a Letter of Intent signed by your parent(s) or legal guardians. This letter must be sincere and complete, stating that you and your parent(s) or legal guardians have read, discussed, and understand the duties described in the Bylaws should you be drawn, and accept the position. The information can be found in the Constitution and Bylaws under Supreme Bethel. You and your parent(s) or legal guardians must sign this letter. You are welcome to write your own letter or you can use the form letter included in this registration packet. If you write your own letter, please include a statement indicating your understanding of the financial commitment for this next year.

SUPREME BETHEL MEETING

The Supreme Bethel meeting is on Thursday, July 31, 2008. This is an official Bethel meeting and those in attendance are expected to dress and act accordingly. Although the meeting is sometimes long, we need to treat this special event with respect for the members of the Supreme Bethel and the work they have done over the past year. Supreme Bethel Honored Queen, Jette Brownlee, will call the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m., to enable our Supreme Guardian, Mrs. Janine Coley, and our Associate Supreme Guardian, Mr. Mike Hogle, as well as the other Supreme Officers to attend the Supreme Bethel Meeting.

PRACTICE FOR THE SUPREME BETHEL MEETING:

All 2007-2008 Supreme Bethel Officers are expected to attend the meeting practice to be held on Wednesday, July 30, 2008, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the Superior/Michigan Room.

SUPREME BETHEL LUNCHEON

Our luncheon will be held at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, July 29th in the Geneva Room. All current SB Officers and Representatives are invited to attend this luncheon. Your SB Committee looks forward to greeting all of you. Your reservation for the luncheon can be made on the registration form for meals which is included in the registration materials for Supreme Session.

PRACTICE FOR SUPREME BETHEL INSTALLATION

If you are chosen as a Supreme Bethel Officer, Representative or Installing Officer, you **MUST** attend the Installation practice which will be held on Friday, August 1st from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. in the Superior/Michigan Room.

INSTALLATION FOR THE 2008-2009 SUPREME BETHEL

The Supreme Bethel Installation of Officers and Representatives for 2008-2009 will be held on Friday evening, August 1st at 7:00 p.m. SHARP. Pictures will be taken prior to the start of Installation and the exact time will be announced during the rehearsal. You can also check your Schedule of Session Activities.

DRESS CODE

Please refer to your Supreme Session booklet for the details relating to the dress code for this Session. For the Supreme Bethel events, the following dress code will be expected for the Daughters and ladies in attendance:

- **Practices:**
Casual dress, no ripped, torn, or low-riding jeans, no midriff tops.
- **Supreme Bethel Meeting:**
A dress or skirt and top. PLEASE – no mini-skirts or midriff-type tops.
- **Supreme Bethel Installation:**
Formal attire.

REGALIA

Daughters selected to serve as Supreme Bethel Officers or Representatives must wear Official Regalia with a white cord and headband to be installed. Make sure everything is clean and pressed for the evening. SBHQ, SBSP, and SBJP do not need cords or headbands. If you are currently serving as an HQ or Princess and plan to enter the drawing for a SB Officer, please bring either an extra set of cords that can be sewn on your robe or perhaps you could have an extra robe with white cords that you can bring with you to Session. Don't forget a headband! You must be present at the practice and Installation to hold this office. Installing Officers will need an appropriate, long formal for the evening. The Supreme Bethel Committee will determine if a dress is not appropriate for the ceremony, so if you are unsure, please check with the committee at the practice or choose another gown.

DRAWING OF OFFICERS

During the Supreme Bethel meeting, the drawing is held for the next year's Officers and Representatives. It is the highlight of the meeting. To be eligible to have your name drawn, you need to register. Following are the rules and procedures for the draw. The rules are found in the Supreme Bethel Rules and Regulations in the Constitution and Bylaws of the JDI.

Draw 1: Supreme Bethel Line Officers (5)

Daughters eligible are HQs and PHQs aged 16-19 years old. Daughters aspiring to these positions must have a **Letter of Intent** signed by them and their parent(s) or legal guardians, stating they are aware of, understand, and are willing to undertake the duties of the office to which they may be selected (SB 6, Article XI, Section I and SB3, Article VII). All Daughters, including the Miss International Job's Daughters contestants, may register for all offices for which they are eligible, including Supreme Bethel Line Officers.

Draw 2: Supreme Bethel Offices (14)

All remaining registered Daughters aged 16-19, including those not selected from Draw 1, may be in the drawing for the Supreme Bethel Officers.

Draw 3: Supreme Bethel Representatives (67)

Every Job's Daughter registered aged 10-19 years old, including those not selected from Draw 1 or 2, may be in the drawing for Supreme Bethel Representatives.

Draw 4: Installing Officers (12)

All Honored Queens and Past Honored Queens may register for this draw.
