High Altitude Tips

When visiting Colorado Springs and the Pikes Peak region, you will need to give your body time to adjust to the altitude. The city of Colorado Springs sits at 6,035 feet above sea level. For the first day in the area, stay below 7,000 feet. Avoid strenuous exercise the first day. Drink lots of water. Work your way up to higher altitudes at about 1,000 feet per day. If you follow these suggestions, you are sure to enjoy each day of your visit to the area.
