

# SUPREME BETHEL

## JOB'S DAUGHTERS INTERNATIONAL



## REGISTRATIONS

All Job's Daughters attending the 2010 Supreme Session in Colorado are encouraged to register for the selection (drawing) of the Supreme Bethel Officers and Representatives for 2010-11.

Please make sure all Daughters attending Supreme Session 2010 receive a copy of this registration packet.

### **AGE**

All Daughters who are in good standing in their Bethel and who will be between 16 and 19 years of age (inclusive) at the time of the Installation of Supreme Bethel Officers (Friday, August 6, 2010) are eligible for all floor offices and representative positions. Daughters between 10 and 19 years of age (inclusive) at the time of the Installation of Supreme Bethel Officers (Friday, August 6, 2010) are eligible for representative positions.

If a Daughter is interested in a position as a Line Officer of the Supreme Bethel, she must also be an Honored Queen or Past Honored Queen at the time of the Installation of Supreme Bethel Officers (August 6, 2010) and must complete a "Letter of Intent" as outlined below.

### **LETTER OF INTENT**

If a Daughter is interested in a position as a Line Officer of the Supreme Bethel, she is required to submit a Letter of Intent with the Supreme Bethel Committee at the time of registration. Your Letter of Intent must be signed by your parent or legal guardian. So, if they are not coming to Supreme Session with you, make sure you have organized this before you leave home. This letter must be sincere and complete, stating that you and your parent(s)/legal guardian(s) have read, discussed and understand the duties described in the Supreme Bethel Rules and Regulations should you be drawn and accept the position. You are welcome to write your own letter or you can use the template that has been developed by the Supreme Bethel Committee. If you write your own letter, please include a statement indicating that you understand and accept the financial commitment for the year.

### **REGISTRATION LOCATION**

The Supreme Bethel registration table will be located in the Crowne Plaza Hotel (headquarters hotel) in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

## **REGISTRATION HOURS**

The Supreme Bethel registration table will be open between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of Supreme Session (August 2nd, 3rd and 4th). However, the registration table may be closed over the lunch hour.

## **SBHQ DISPLAY TABLE**

## **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO TO REGISTER**

You must have and show a current and valid Dues Card. This is required in order to ensure that you are an active member of Job's Daughters.

You must come to the registration table with your chaperone who will be required to counter-sign your registration card.

You must be wearing your official 2010 Supreme Session Registration Name Badge. This is required in order to ensure that you are registered to attend Supreme Session and have, therefore, paid the Supreme Bethel registration fee. Your name badge will be clipped by a member of the Supreme Bethel Committee. This will indicate that you have registered for Supreme Bethel and that you may attend the Supreme Bethel meeting.

If you are registering for a Line Office, you must bring your Letter of Intent with you.

## **SUPREME BETHEL MEETING**

The Supreme Bethel meeting will be held on Thursday, August 5, 2010 at 7:30 am. This is a closed Bethel meeting and those in attendance should be dressed appropriately. Although this meeting is sometimes long, this is a special event for the members of the Supreme Bethel who have put in a lot of work over the past year. Therefore, we ask that you behave with the relevant respect expected during a Bethel meeting. Supreme Bethel Honored Queen Arielle will call the meeting to order at 7:30 am sharp to allow the Supreme Guardian, Mrs. Elaine Gray, and Associate Supreme Guardian, Mr. Dave Robblee, and other Supreme Officers and voting delegates to be in attendance.

## **SUPREME BETHEL LUNCHEON**

If you are currently a 2009-10 Supreme Bethel Officer or Representative and you will be attending Supreme Session 2010 in Colorado Springs, Colorado, you are invited to attend the luncheon for Supreme Bethel Officers and Representatives. Arielle and the Supreme Bethel Committee look forward to greeting you and hearing all about your year on Supreme Bethel. The luncheon will be held in the Crowne Plaza Hotel on Tuesday, August 3, 2010 from 12:00 – 1:30 pm. Make sure you register for the luncheon when you register for Supreme Session in Colorado.

A new event at this year's Supreme Session, will be a breakfast for all Past Supreme Bethel Honored Queens. It will be held on Friday, August 6 from 9:00 - 10:30 am in the Crowne Plaza Hotel. ## **PRACTICE FOR THE SUPREME BETHEL MEETING**

If you are currently a 2009-10 Supreme Bethel Officer or Representative and you will be attending Supreme Session 2010 in Colorado Springs, Colorado, you are required to attend the practice for the Supreme Bethel meeting. This will be held on Wednesday, August 4, 2010 from 9:30 – 11:30 am at the Crowne Plaza Hotel.

## **PRACTICE FOR SUPREME BETHEL INSTALLATION**

If you are selected as a Supreme Bethel Officer or Representative or Installing Officer for 2010-11, you are required to attend the installation practice. This will be held on Friday, August 6, 2010 from 9:00 – 11:00 am at the Crowne Plaza Hotel.

## **INSTALLATION OF 2010-11 SUPREME BETHEL**

The Installation of Supreme Bethel Officers and Representatives for 2010-11 will be held on the evening of Friday, August 6, 2010 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel. If you are selected as a Supreme Bethel Officer or Representative or Installing Officer, you will be required to attend. Photographs will be held prior to the commencement of the Installation Ceremony. An exact time will be announced during the Supreme Bethel meeting or check your schedule of events once you arrive at Supreme Session in Colorado.

## **DRESS CODE**

Please refer to your Supreme Session booklet for details relating to dress codes for this Session. For Supreme Bethel events, the following dress code is expected:

- Practices: Casual dress: no ripped, torn, cut-off or low-riding jeans; no midriff tops; no tank-tops.
- Supreme Bethel Meeting: Bethel Regalia or dress or skirt and blouse: no miniskirts; no low cut, backless, see-through or midriff-style tops.
- Supreme Bethel Installation: Formal attire: cocktail to formal length; no strapless or backless dresses. Wear appropriate formal footwear: no flip-flops.

## **REGALIA FOR OFFICERS AND REPRESENTATIVES**

Daughters selected to serve as Supreme Bethel Officers or Representatives must wear official regalia to be installed into office. This includes long white slip, white hose and white shoes. Supreme Bethel Honored Queen and Princesses do not need cords and headbands. All other Officers and Representatives must wear cords and headbands. If you are currently serving as an Honored Queen or Princess and you are registering for a position on Supreme Bethel, please either bring a spare robe with cords attached or a spare set of cords that can be sewn onto your robe for the installation.

## **DRESS CODE FOR INSTALLING OFFICERS**

Installing Officers will need an appropriate, full-length formal dress for the installation. Please no strapless or backless dresses. Please wear appropriate formal footwear: no flip-flops. The Supreme Bethel Committee reserves the right to determine if a dress is not appropriate for the ceremony; so if you are unsure, please check with the Supreme Bethel Guardian prior to the installation.

## **DRAWING OF SUPREME BETHEL OFFICERS, REPRESENTATIVES AND INSTALLING OFFICERS**

During the Supreme Bethel meeting, the drawing is held for next year's Officers and Representatives. It is the highlight of the meeting. Please refer to the Supreme Bethel Rules and Regulations regarding the rules for eligibility and registering and the process for drawing. ### **Draw 1 – Supreme Bethel Line Officers**

Supreme Bethel Line Officers shall be drawn from registered Honored Queens and Past Honored Queens who are at least sixteen (16) years of age as of Friday, August 6, 2010, and have not reached their majority at the time of the Supreme Bethel installation.

### **Draw 2 – Other Supreme Bethel Officers**

Other Officers shall be selected from registered members who are at least sixteen (16) years of age as of Friday, August 6, 2010, and have not reached their majority. This includes Honored Queens and Past Honored Queens not selected in Draw 1.

**Draw 3 – Supreme Bethel Representatives**

Supreme Bethel Representatives shall be selected from all members who have not reached their majority. This includes members not previously selected in Draws 1 or 2.

**Draw 4 – Installing Officers**

Supreme Bethel Installing Officers shall be selected from registered Honored Queens and Past Honored Queens (not previously selected) who are at least sixteen (16) years of age as of Friday, August 6, 2010, and have not reached their majority.
